At 9/2003 PS CROSS and PC 3909 DEVADASAN were on FIT team duties with the Metropolitan Police Oracle Units at the DSEI exhibition.

At 1135 hours officers attended a demonstration outside the Custom House Hotel opposite CUSTOM HOUSE DLR Station. The group consisted of 20 persons both male and female. One of the organisers was Mr. [REDACTED] who earlier in the week had been running a training class for non violent direct action at Trinity Methodist Church, 119 EAST INDIA DOCK ROAD. The demonstration was peaceful with no problems.

At 1225 hours Emily APPLE entered CUSTOM HOUSE DLR. She went on to the westbound Silverlink platform and waited for a train. She was wearing a black top with the hood up, blue jeans, black shoes and was carrying a brown shoulder bag.

She got onto the 1243 hours Silverlink train and alighted at HACKNEY CENTRAL Station. She was followed along MORNING LANE, HACKNEY E9. She entered the pub in morning lane public house.

At 1320 hours she left the pub and walked a few hundred yards into a charity shop on MORNING LANE whilst in the shop she was peering on her mobile phone.

She went in and out of several shops in an apparent attempt to get away from the FIT team officers.

At 1330 hours Emily APPLE was followed into [REDACTED]. She was seen entering [REDACTED], which was in a block of flats on the right hand side of the road near the junction with [REDACTED] ROAD. The officers could not see any visible signs to identify the name of the estate.

At 1400 hours an ICI MALE, proportionate build and wearing a baseball cap opened the door looked outside and then went back in to the flat.

At 1440 hours 3 ICI FEMALES entered the flat.

At 1530 hours two vehicles were seen parked in [REDACTED] ROAD

- 1) WHITE LEYLAND DAF VAN INDEX [REDACTED]
- 2) RED VOLKSWAGEN CAMPER VAN [REDACTED]

Both vehicles were checked on PNC and belonged to local residents with no apparent connection to the address
